I. <u>Purpose</u>

The purpose of this policy is toprovide a place for friends and family of persons involved in a fatal traffic accident to memorialize their loved shap placing memorials in the Townright of way in a safe and respectful manner.

II. Policy/Procedure

Physical Requirements:

- 1. A roadside memorial would not be more than-20thesin height (measured from the groundsurface), 24-inchesin width (measured along the roadway) in the chesin depth (measured perpendicular to the road way).
- 2. To ensure public safety, unattendedndles, glass or sharp objects, on anther features determined the Public Works Director be unsaferor the publicare not allowed to be included in roadside memorials. These items will be immediately removed by the town.
- 3. Music or loud noise will of be allowed.
- 4. The memorial would be located as close as possible to the site of death, but it may vary depending on the site and safety conditions. This decision is at the discretion of the town.
- 5. If a roadside memorial encroaches on private property, piesion will need to be obtained from the property owner.

Regulations:

The placement of a roadside memorial would be allowed along a public sidewalk, roadway or rightof-way owned and maintained by the town anytime withdays after a death due to a tagic event as long as:

- 1. The roadside memorial complies with all State of Connecticut and Town of Bloomfield laws, rules, and regulations that govern all roadways and roadways.
- The roadside memorial does not cause unsafe conditions for passing mstorist pedestrians, or for people maintaining or visiting the roadside memorial, as determined by the town.
- 3. Memorials will not be permitted in a construction or maintenance work zone until such time the work is completed (the town will reserve the right to permarily remove or relocate a memorial at any time for street and/or rightway maintenance or construction operations or activities such as paving, snow removal and roadside mowing

Registration Process:
