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The Certified Public Infrastructure Inspector examination consists of 150 multiple-choice questions. Candidates a given 35 hours to complete the computer-based examination.

APWA recommends that review for the CPII examination focus on resourcesparograms that cover the information summarized in the CPII examination content outline. The percentage of questions in each domain is provided.

The questions on the examination assume that the candidate possesses practical, hands-o experience of at least five years in the public infrastructure inspection field and is familiar with common practices in North America, especially in the United States. Some test questions may ask candidates to select the best of availableions. Usually, thebest response is the onesed most broadly across North America as the correspondent to the policy or procedure.

No preparatory materials are prerequisites to earning APWA certifications. Howeverne materials can help you refresh and prove your understanding of the processes and functions.

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
